



ellaOne® Pregnancy Registry

What is the Pregnancy Registry?

A pregnancy registry is a program that collects medical information on women who have been exposed to a pharmaceutical product during pregnancy.

The ellaOne® Pregnancy Registry collects information about pregnancy outcomes in women who:

- took ellaOne® while they were already pregnant, or
- became pregnant after taking ellaOne®.

The existence of a registry does **not** mean that there is a known risk for you or your baby if you have taken ellaOne® during pregnancy.

The information collected will help increase knowledge about exposure to ellaOne® during pregnancy. In the long-term, other pregnant women may benefit from your participation through the data collected in this registry.

What is ellaOne®?

ellaOne® is an emergency contraceptive for women, to be taken within five days of unprotected sexual intercourse or contraceptive failure (for example, if a condom breaks).

If you would like more information about ellaOne® or about this registry, please ask your physician or health care professional.

How Can You Participate?

If you have inadvertently taken ellaOne® during your pregnancy, or if you became pregnant despite having taken ellaOne®, we are very interested in receiving information about your pregnancy. Any information will be handled in a strictly anonymous manner to protect your confidentiality.

You may report information directly through this website, or you may ask your physician or health care professional to report the information on your behalf. In all cases, you are strongly advised to contact your physician or health care professional as early as possible during your pregnancy.

If you choose to participate, you or your physician/health care professional may report medical information regarding your health, your pregnancy and whenever necessary, your baby's birth and health.

Participation in this registry will **not** require additional doctor visits and does **not** involve taking any medication.

If you know someone who has taken ellaOne® during pregnancy or shortly before becoming pregnant, we strongly encourage you to inform her about this registry.

Your participation is very important. The information you provide may help improve knowledge and support other women in the future.



How Is Your Confidentiality Ensured?

The information you enter in this online questionnaire is transmitted through a secure electronic system.

Your identity will remain strictly confidential. Personal data are limited to your initials and date of birth, which are collected solely to allow appropriate follow-up of the reported information. These personal data are encrypted so that your identity cannot be identified by HRA Pharma. The information collected in the registry is not sufficient to identify individual patients.

If you choose to register, the system will send you follow-up emails to ask whether you would like to provide additional information about your pregnancy. At this stage, HRA Pharma does not have access to your name or email address.

If you decide to respond to emails and agree to provide further information by email, your email address will then be known to the Global Patient Safety Department. Even in this case, your personal data will remain strictly confidential and will be used exclusively for safety monitoring purposes.

If you also choose to provide your physician's or health care professional's contact details, they may be contacted if important information is missing or unclear.

Important Information Before Completing the Questionnaire

Completing this questionnaire will only take a few minutes.

Once submitted, you will be able to log back in and view the information you entered. If you have not completed all sections of the registry and would like to provide additional information at a later stage, you will be invited to do so.
